**Whisper 1 is for Mad Max** from Nicky Henderson's yard who is to be aimed at Cheltenham in the Supreme Novices Hurdle and can land the spoils here. Watch out for this one.

**Whisper 2 is for Kalahari King** from Ferdy Murphy's Yard who is to be aimed for the Arkle Chase at Cheltenham and should give good account and will win more races for his shrewd trainer.

**Whisper 3 is for Barber's Shop** from Nicky Henderson's yard and is improving fast and will be better suited to 3 mile plus chase races and has the class to shock the best chasers into submission in the chase races.

**Whisper 4 is for Dee Ee Williams** from Nicky Gifford's yard who ran well below expectations at Haydock and has a real future over hurdles. Losses are only lent here.

**Whisper 5 is for Ashkazar** from David Pipe's yard and last time out at Ascot the ground was all wrong. Must have good ground to show his best and can land a decent prize this season at decent S. P.

**Whisper 6 is for Imperial Commander** from Nigel Twiston-Davies yard who found Kauto Star too good at Kempton in the King George, but back over 2 mile 5 furlongs is a force to be reckoned with. Just be on.

**Whisper 7 is for Karabak** from Alan King's yard and hasn't stopped improving. Simply destroyed a top class field of novices carrying top weight at Ascot and must be followed till defeated.

**Whisper 8 is for Diamond Harry** from Nick William's yard and has won all his hurdle races in style and Cheltenham is next – The Ballymore Property Novice Hurdle – and has the class to give a good account.

**Whisper 9 is for Will Be Done** from Donald McCain's Yard who won well at Haydock recently. This novice chaser is

surely on the upgrade and can win more races over the 2½ mile chase trip.

**Whisper 10 is for Cloudy Lane** from Donald McCain's yard who is a top class chaser and at around 3m to 3½ miles is hard to beat even with top weight and should find another race before end of the season.
